Option 1: Leadership Team

A Team Focused on Leading and Leadership Development

College Leadership is a guided opportunity to serve the church and grow in ministry leadership. Jesus has tasked the church with making disciples of all nations. This leadership team of three to five leaders will prayerfully lead the North Central College Ministry in the areas of prayer, Bible study, missions, and discipleship. Leaders will be given opportunities for leadership development and will have considerable leadership roles in Sunday morning activities, Family Groups, Mission trips, and other North Central Activities.

What are the requirements?

- ▶ Be between 18 and 24 years of age.
- ▶ Be currently enrolled or plan to be enrolled at UF or Santa Fe in Fall 2018.
- ▶ Be willing to devote time and emotional energy into serving the college ministry at North Central. Applications from recent graduates will be accepted, but recent grad applicants must be willing to invest time in college ministry that often comes easier to those still in college.
- ▶ Be willing to be a leader in Life Lab, a Family Group, North Central's College Retreat, Mission Trip, and other events and initatives.
- ▶ Show current consistent commitment to Christian living including: a concern for the lost and a current personal ministry that reflects that, a desire to seek reconcilation and live peaceably with others, and most importantly a love for Jesus and the church.

Option 2: Servant Team

A team of people who want to serve the church and college ministry.

The Servant Team is a group of servants and ambassadors of North Central. This team will help set up events, encourage leaders, welcome students to church, and take part in a monthly time of prayer for the church. This team is perfect for students who have leadership roles in other places, but would like the opportunity to serve without the high commitment that the leadership team entails.
