Safety and cleanliness have always been a priority, but we have some new procedures for this year! Here are some things to keep in mind as you enter the children's areas today:

NO CONTACT CHECK IN:

- When you are entering the preschool area there will be a table where a worker will check your child in and provide you with a sticker for your child and a "ticket" with your child's number for pickup. In the event of an emergency the phone number on file will be texted.
- When you arrive at the children's modular, a worker will greet your child outside and escort them to their class inside of the modular. To avoid extra traffic inside the children's area, no adults, besides workers, will enter the modular. Pickup and drop off will all take place outside of the modular doors.

TEMPERATURE CHECKS:

- Anyone entering the children's areas will have their temperature checked before entering. A temperature of 99 degrees or lower is require to enter the children's areas.

HAND WASHING:

- Anyone entering the children's area is required to wash their hands, or use hand sanitizer, immediately. Hand washing or sanitizing of hands will also be encouraged throughout the designated times in the children's areas and before leaving.

MASKS:

- All NCBC volunteers are required to wear masks while in the children's area. Children Kingergaren-5th Grade will also be asked to wear a mask while in the children's areas.

REMINDERS:

- Please do not bring your child to class if they (or anyone in your household) are showing signs of illness. If you or your children have had significant exposure to someone who is COVID positive, please stay home and monitor your symptoms.

PICK UP AND DROP OFF:

- Drop Off: When you arrive at the children's modular, a worker will greet your child outside and escort them to their class inside of the modular. To avoid extra traffic inside the children's area, no adults, besides workers, will enter the modular.
- Pick Up: Please form a line along the modular ramp when coming to pick up your children. A worker will meet you at the door and will escort your child out to meet you.

TEMPERATURE CHECKS:

- Anyone entering the children's areas will have their temperature checked before entering. A temperature of 99 degrees or lower is required to enter the children's areas.

HAND WASHING AND SANITIZING:

- Anyone entering the children's area is required to wash their hands, or use hand sanitizer, immediately. Hand washing or sanitizing of hands will also be encouraged throughout the designated times in the children's areas and before leaving.

MASKS:

- All NCBC volunteers are required to wear masks while in the children's area. Children Kingergaren-5th Grade will also be asked to wear a mask while in the children's modular.

ACTIVITIES AND SUPPLIES:

- Seating inside of the modular will be marked and socially distanced. Children will have individual supplies to use. Supplies or toys that are shared communally will be sanitized after use. Activities will be chosen to avoid close contact with other children and adults.
